The National Institute of Archaeology and Museum at the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences (NIAM-BAS) covers the complete study of the culture of tribes and peoples who have occupied present day Bulgaria from the remote past until the 18th century. NIAM-BAS is a national center and coordinator of all field research in Bulgaria and exercises scholarly and methodological control on it. The Museum of Archaeology hosts the most numerous collections in Bulgaria and its exhibitions reveal it as one of the most important centers in the country for promotion of the cultural heritage of present day Bulgaria. Its academic and museum potential turns NIAM-BAS into the biggest research archaeological unit in southeast Europe.

- ❖ Later prehistory; Neolithic, Chalcolithic & Early Bronze Age; Southeast Europe, Anatolia & the Levant; prehistoric mortuary practices; religio-mythological beliefs of the early farmers
